José Borbinha has a background in Electrical Engineering and a PhD in Computer Science. He is an Assistant Professor at the Information Systems and Computer Engineering Department at IST (Lisbon Technical University), and a researcher of the Information Systems Group at INESC-ID.

His main interests are in the areas of research, analysis, planning and development of technology, systems and services in the field of information systems and enterprise architecture in general. In special, he is interested in addressing problems of requirements, analysis and design, especially when they involve scenarios of interoperability and document engineering (including problems on descriptive and structural metadata and digital preservation).

José Borbinha was the Director for Innovation and Development at the National Library of Portugal between 1998 and 2005. During that period he promoted the initiative for the National Digital Library.

He has been an active member in several European projects and initiatives in the area of digital libraries (DELOS, LEAF, TEL, MALVINE, NEDLIB, MinervaPlus, DIGMAP, etc.) and member of the Programme Committees of the major international conferences in the area (JCDL, ECDL, RCDL, ICADL). He have take part of review and advising actions in his areas of expertise for the European Commission and the National Science Foundation (USA)

José Borbinha is member of the ACM – Association for Computer Machinery and of the IEEE - Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers. He is a founding member of the IEEE Technical Committee on Digital Libraries, and member of the Advisory Boards of the Dublin Core Metadata Initiative and of the Networked Digital Thesis and Dissertations initiative. He is a member of the Portuguese Society of Engineers (“Ordem dos Engenheiros”) and of the Portuguese Association of Librarians, Archivists and Documentalists (“Associação Portuguesa de Bibliotecários, Arquivistas e Documentalistas”).
